

# Calculate the value of your contents



**This guide will help you work out how much contents insurance you need. Then we can help protect those things that matter to you.**

When working out how much contents cover you need, you need to think about the possessions you own. Everything from your clothes, books and sheets, to your kitchen utensils and computers.

The 'sum insured' on your policy is the maximum amount you can claim. That's why it's so important to set the right figure. You should also check your policy wording to see what you are covered for.

If you are an existing customer, you might have calculated your contents when you took out your policy. But if you've purchased anything since then, it could be worth reviewing.

We've put together a list of contents that may be in your house. We recommend you go from room to room in your home and write down the approximate value of each item. Jewellery, antiques and fine art are more difficult to value – sometimes a professional valuation is required.

The total amount of all the items represents how much contents cover you need.

We will pay up to the sum insured as stated in your certificate of currency or less, subject to the terms and conditions of your contents wordings. Please refer to the detail of the terms, conditions and exclusions.
